Re-establish roses now a drench of root stimulator, ¼ cup Triple-Super Phosphate, 1 cup Bone Meal, 1 cup Limestone, ¼ Cup Minor Elements, & 1 Teaspoon Calcium Nitrate Light Pruning to shape rose bushes (For wet areas use 1 cup Gypsum) Insects - Aphids - Orthene or Organocide Chilli Thrips - Naturalyte or Orthene 2 times a week

Planting bare root roses • Soak entire rose bush in water for 8-24 h • Dig hole 18-30 inches wide and deep to accommodate root ball • Add 1 cup sulfur and 1 cup triple superphosphate and mix
