How are Parts of the Brain Related to Brain Function?

•One technique for studying the brain is the CT scan (computed tomography) •With this technique, a beam of x-rays is shot through the brain, identifying bone, grey matter, and fluid •A computer then reconstructs an image of each slice or brain section allowing abnormalities in structure to be detected
